2022 Covid Plan

With this new wave of Covid in our school, our school administration updated the current policy with guidance from the Covid Task Force Team.

As always, we take the safety and well-being of our students, staff, and families into consideration when making decisions and changes.

Please direct any questions regarding this plan to the school administration.

Again, we want to have our kids in school, keeping in mind every case is unique. We look at each case individually to make the best decision.

- If a student or any other family member within the same household tests positive, that student and any siblings must stay home and quarantine.
- All other students in that class that are healthy will stay in class, but will wear a mask for 5 consecutive days (Pre-K/Kindergarten mask encouraged, but not required).
- Students with Covid will stay out a minimum of 5 days, maybe longer, depending on symptoms. The 5 day quarantine begins at the onset of symptoms or a positive test. Students must be asymptomatic to return.
- Any quarantined student will wear a mask 5 consecutive days after they return from having a Covid case (Pre-K/Kindergarten mask encouraged, but not required).
- Any parent uncomfortable sending their student to a class that has a current Covid case, may keep their student home with an excused absence for only the duration of quarantine time. Virtual Learning will not be available if you choose this option. Parents will need to communicate with the Teacher/Office to create a plan of action.
- Any student in a class that has a positive Covid case that shows symptoms during this time will also be sent home.
- A negative Covid test will not be required for students to return after the 5 day quarantine has passed.
- As a reminder, no sick child will be allowed at school. This includes colds, flus, and such. If a student is sick, they need to stay home, and this will be enforced. If a student is showing any symptoms on campus they will be sent to the Office for evaluation.
- We will continue to monitor and check the CDC recommendations. This plan will be adjusted if necessary.
